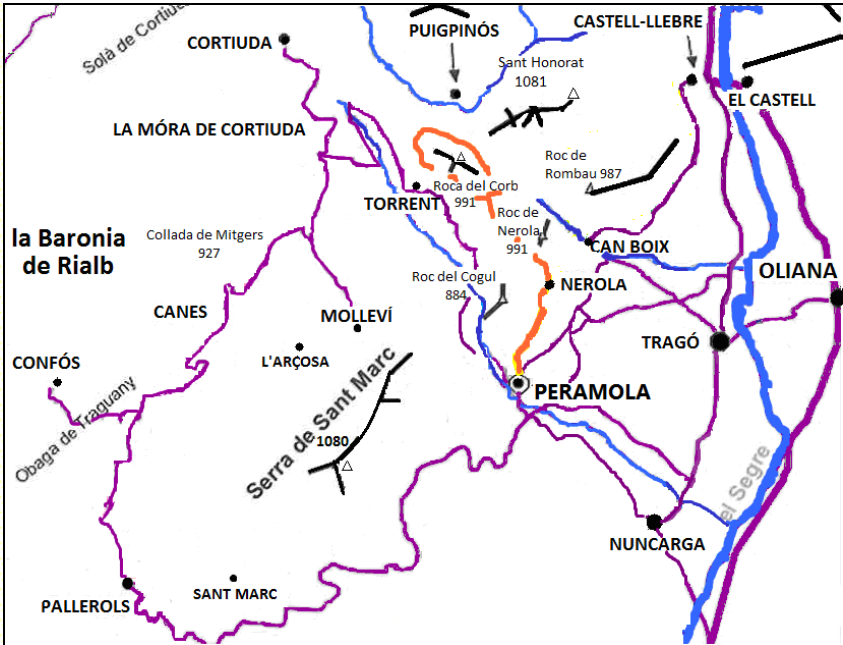


# “LA ROCA DEL CORB” – THE CROW’S ROCK



West of the Segre and Peramola village stands a solid Pre-Pyrenean cluster. Its height is moderate, but surprised by the rugged terrain and cliffs. There is a way to have access on a single circuit, on the tops of La Roca del Corb (1.123m) and the mountain of Sant Honorat.

**ITINERARY:** Peramola – Nerola – Grau de Porta – Casa del Corb – Coll de Mur – Sant Salvador del Corb – Roc de Cogul – Roc del Ros – Peramola.

## TIPS TO KEEP THE ROAD:

Go following signs for route del Corb path found in the chapel of the Rosary Peramola.

**DIFFICULTY:** low

**KIND OF ROUTE:** round

**SIGNALPOSTING:** no

**TIME:** 3h 10 min

**TIME: 3h. 10 min.** Peramola to Grau de Porta: 40 minutes / Grau de Porta to Roca del Corb: 45 minutes / Roca del Corb to Coll de Mur: 30 minutes / Coll de Mur to house of Corb: 15 minutes / Corb's house to Serradell de les Cerquetes: 20 minutes / From Serradell de les Cerquetes to Peramola: 40 minutes

## SIGHTS:

There is a superb view of Sant Salvador del Corb to crops Segre Valley.

The grotto or cave Corb is a living space, almost without interruption from prehistory to the first third of the twentieth century.
